

PARK OF THE WEEK RECAP – OCTOBER 22

MIAMI LAKES, Fla.— The Orange Bowl Youth Football Alliance (Orange Bowl YFA) presented by Sports Authority visited four sites on Saturday, October 22, 2011 as part of its Park of the Week program. The Orange Bowl YFA Park of the Week program presented by Sports Authority recognizes select youth football teams across South Florida each Saturday during the fall.

This past Park of the Week schedule involved visits to the Fort Pierce Seminoles and Pahokee Baby Blue Devils of the Glades Tri-City Youth Athletic League, the Dania Bears of the Miami Xtreme Youth Football League and the Washington Park Buccaneers of the National Youth Football League. The Orange Bowl YFA has three competitive leagues and six recreational leagues under its umbrella.

Now in its 13th season, the Orange Bowl YFA presented by Sports Authority serves more than 16,000 young football players and cheerleaders in nine youth football leagues across nine South Florida counties and has invested approximately \$4.5 million in youth sports in South Florida since 1999.
