TEAM ARRIVALS

Team airport arrivals on Sunday, Dec. 26 are open to credentialed media. The head coaches and select student-athletes will be made available to media planeside. The ACC team (home team) will arrive at Fort Lauderdale International Airport Jet Center (Sheltair Aviation) and the SEC/B1G/ND team (visiting team) will arrive at Miami International Airport (Signature Flight Support). Dates/times and locations are subject to change. Please contact the Orange Bowl Communications Department for additional instructions.

OFFICIAL MEDIA HEADQUARTERS

The Le Meridien Dania Beach at Fort Lauderdale Airport located at 1825 Griffin Rd, Dania Beach, FL 33004 will serve as the Official Media Headquarters for the 2022 Capital One Orange Bowl. A room block has been secured for media at the rate of \$221/night. Rooms can be reserved [HERE](#).

All bowl week press conferences will take place at the media hotel. Team and bowl materials will be available in the media workroom as well as daily practice reports, schedule updates, notes and quotes. Additionally, credentialed media will have access to the Larry Wahl Media Hospitality Room daily until 12 a.m.

CREDENTIALS

Media can apply for credentials to the 89th Capital One Orange Bowl at <https://www.orangebowl.org/pressbox/> beginning Monday, Nov. 21, 2022. The deadline to apply is Wednesday, Dec. 14, 2022 at 5 p.m.

All credentials and parking passes may be picked up at the Official Media Headquarters in Seven Isles Executive Boardroom at Le Meridien Dania Beach at Fort Lauderdale Airport from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. ET on Dec. 27-28, or 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. on Dec. 29.

Media can also pick up credentials on game day (not parking) at Hard Rock Stadium Media Will Call (located at SW Gate) on Dec. 30. **NO MEDIA CREDENTIALS WILL BE MAILED.**

MEDIA WORK ROOM

The Media Work Room will be located in Bahia-Barcelona on the second floor of the media hotel. The room will be equipped with high-speed internet connectivity. The workroom's hours of operation are 7 a.m. – 12 a.m. ET.

MEDIA HOSPITALITY

The Larry Wahl Media Hospitality Room is located in Venice-Lago Bay on the second floor of the media hotel. Members of the media are encouraged to spend their downtime in the hospitality room enjoying snacks and beverages courtesy of Orange Bowl. The hospitality room is open from 7 a.m. until 12 a.m. daily.

TEAM PRACTICES

Team practices are open to media to shoot b-roll and take photos for the first 15 minutes on Tuesday, Dec. 27 and Wednesday, Dec. 28 in a distanced area off the field and away from the teams.

MEDIA SHUTTLES

The Orange Bowl Communications Department will provide courtesy shuttles from the Le Meridien Dania Beach to Hard Rock Stadium on the day of the game. Shuttles will pick up credentialed media near outside the lobby of the media hotel and drop off near Gate SE of Hard Rock Stadium.

Shuttle Schedule (Pregame):

- Bus 1: Departs Media Hotel at 3:45 p.m.
- Bus 2: Departs Media Hotel at 5:00 p.m.

Shuttle Schedule (Postgame):

- Bus 1: Departs Hard Rock Stadium (outside Gate SE) 30 minutes after conclusion of game
- Bus 2: Departs Hard Rock Stadium (outside Gate SE) 2 hours after conclusion of game

LIVE TELECASTS

On game day, non-originating telecasters may originate live programming from the field pregame in a designated roped-off area until 45 minutes before kickoff (7:15 p.m. ET). Live programming may resume postgame after the teams have cleared the field and ESPN has concluded its live coverage from the site, at which time television stations or networks may use up to three minutes of footage for television news highlight purposes during the 72 hours after the game. All footage must contain the ESPN logo throughout and must be accompanied by the graphic "Courtesy ESPN."
