

ORANGE BOWL CFB150 DECADES CAMPAIGN

Rules Governing the Conduct and Operation of the Contest

The Orange Bowl Committee, Inc., a Florida nonprofit and 501(c)(3) corporation (the "Orange Bowl"), whose principal place of business is located at 14360 N.W. 77th Court, Miami Lakes, Florida 33016, is conducting the following contest:

Fans have the opportunity to vote for their favorite Orange Bowl game of each decade for a chance to win two (2) tickets to the 2019 Capital One Orange Bowl. **This Contest is limited to persons 18 years of age or older who are residents of the State of Florida and accurately complete and submit entries in accordance with these Contest Rules.**

The Orange Bowl will weekly post on its website four (4) games from each decade in Orange Bowl's history (1930's through 2010's) for participating eligible fans to vote for at orangebowl.org/cfb150. Fans will have to enter their personal information (name, email address, date of birth and other applicable information, etc.) before submitting their vote to the poll. Only fully completed and properly uploaded votes will be accepted. The Orange Bowl will not be responsible for late, incomplete, or misdirected votes which shall be automatically deemed ineligible for the Contest, provided, that, no entrant shall be arbitrarily removed, disqualified, disallowed, or rejected or discriminated against in any manner between entrants who gave contributions to the organization and those who did not give such contributions.

No purchase, contribution, entry fee, donation, substantial consideration, payment, or proof of purchase is required as a condition of entering the drawing or of being selected to win a prize.

Votes will be accepted from October 10, 2019 through December 11, 2019. Votes must be submitted with a date and time no later than December 11, 2016 at 11:59 PM EST.

Odds of winning depend on the number of actual entries submitted during the Contest period. The Orange Bowl selection committee will select one (1) overall winner at random after the completion of the Contest. The winner will be selected at the Orange Bowl's principal place of business on Thursday, December 12, 2019 at 12 PM EST in which two (2) Capital One Orange Bowl tickets (face value \$390 value) will be awarded. The Orange Bowl will promptly notify, at the address set forth on the entry blank, any person whose entry is selected to win of the fact that he or she won. Winners will be required to sign a Declaration of Eligibility and Release.

If the winner does not sign such Declaration of Eligibility and Release within seven (7) calendar days of the Orange Bowl notifying him/her of his/her selection, the Orange Bowl reserves the right to select another winner at random, which right may be exercised in the Orange Bowl's sole discretion.

Winner will be responsible for any federal, state, and local taxes on prizes (where applicable).

All decisions, including, without limitation, eligibility and whether votes were properly and timely submitted, shall be determined solely by the Orange Bowl Committee and such decisions are final and binding.

The source of the funds to make the award is from the Orange Bowl's internal operating funds.

Employees of the Orange Bowl Committee, their affiliates, subsidiaries, distributors, suppliers, advertising, pricing and promotion agencies and the “immediate families” of each are not eligible to win. The term “immediate families” includes spouse, parents, and children.

Prizes are not redeemable for cash. No substitutions for prizes can be made. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.
